### C8 Corvette Production News

### The Latest On The 2024 and 2025 Corvette

The 2024 Corvette adds new active safety tech to its features list to bring it more in line with other Chevy models, <u>including Automatic Emergency Braking</u> and <u>standard IntelliBeam</u> automatic high-beam headlamps as well as Lane Keep Assist and Lane Departure Warning.

For 2024 it also gets <u>new driver mode selection animations</u> and a <u>new infotainment system incorporating Google</u> built-in features. According to a J.D. Power Study, the Chevy Corvette already has a great multimedia system.

The <u>2024 Corvette Stingray also drops two alloy wheel choices</u>, replacing them with new designs. Check out all the <u>2024 Corvette wheel options</u>. Furthermore, the <u>2024 Corvette gets a new Edge Red painted rear fascia script</u> as an LPO-level option.



The 2024 <u>Stingray's M1L transmission gets a case design update</u> and, critically, will no longer require two extra quarts of transmission fluid for track use. It should be noted that GM does not condone tracking M1L-equipped vehicles without the Z51 package.

The rumor about the C8 HVAC controls, aka the "Great Wall of Buttons" changing in 2025 is still just a rumor. Many sources can not agree if they will be changed in 2025 models or not .... We'll see ...



**ZR1 NEWS:** Chevrolet confirmed on April 10<sup>th</sup>, that the King of Corvettes will debut this summer with deliveries in 2025. Watch the GM ZR1 Video here!

The ZR1 will be the ultimate track-focused version of the eighth-generation, mid-engine C8 Corvette. The 2025 ZR1 is expected to carry the same screaming flat-plane crank 5.5-liter engine as the Z06 — but with added twin turbochargers to juice the rearwheel-drive, track monster to over 850 horsepower.

The ZR1's turbocharged engine is designated LT7. With twin turbochargers, the 5.5-liter LT7 engine should propel the 2025 ZR1 to sub-2.5 second 0-60 times with perhaps 850 horsepower and 825 pound-feet of torque. Expect the ZR1 to dress up with a huge rear wing and front spoiler to suck the beast to the ground around high-speed bends.

### The Club Highway Beautification Project - Spring 2024

20 Club Members braved the looming weather, strong winds and parked their Corvettes on Saturday morning, April 6<sup>th</sup> to participate in the Spring Edition of the Club's Highway Beautification event. Once again, Ted Severn and Gary Walters masterfully arranged all the supplies, equipment and safety gear needed to complete the project. We were able to police up our little mile of the Colorado Highways without anyone being hit by a car, bitten by a snake, or suffering a stroke. Unfortunately, no one found any cash, credit cards, winning lottery tickets or the like unlike previous events ... Enjoy the pix below!













Autocrossing is a GREAT way to see how well you and your car can handle corners, maneuvering around cones and speed. You can drive as fast or slow as you are comfortable with (even though it is a timed event). You are not driving next to other cars so there is no one near you while you are out on the track. If you're not ready to take your car out quite yet, you can grab a ride with a driver that is willing to take on a passenger. You will need an Approved Snell Helmet (less than 10 years old) and closed-toed shoes. CSCC does have some loaner helmets.



Like most events, you will need to go to coloradospringscorvetteclub.org, Events calendar and register for the event you're interested in. You aren't obligated to show but registering ahead of time does help registration if you do come. If this is your first time you will register as a "Novice". You can pay at the event (cash or check). The flyer for the event will give you lots of information as to how many races, cost, location etc. When you first get to the event you will go to the registration table and get a Tech Sheet, which is signed off by a Tech

Person once they've determined that your car is safe to race. \*\*Make sure to remove all the loose objects from inside your car before you get your car inspected!.

**Tires:** Next, be sure you have adequate tire pressure, with cold pressures at least what is noted on the driver's door jamb. If you drive an older Corvette with high-profile tires, you should add more pressure. You can race with tires that have no tread remaining, provided there are no cords showing. You are responsible for driving a safe car, so if you have any issues, please get them sorted before arriving at the track. As with many things, tire pressures will affect your run time—experience will help you gain needed knowledge in this area. Many of the seasoned drivers will be using extra-sticky dedicated race tires.

**Numbers**: You need to put numbers on your car so we can identify you when you are out there. Registration will assign you a number for the day's race or NCCC members can apply for a dedicated two-digit number that will be good for the year. You should apply the numbers to both sides of your car, at least 8" high and in a contrasting color to your car. We have blue painter's tape available. You can use your car for two drivers, but each driver need's a separate number. Run a piece of tape across the numbers not being used to block it out for each race.



Venues are normally a large parking lot or a dedicated racetrack; if it's a parking lot or pad you typically walk the course, walking with a veteran racer will help with pointers and cone positions that you need to aware of, like "pointer cones" (sometimes a course map is provided). If it's a racetrack, a couple of "parade laps" (cars go out and follow each other) are done to show you the course.

**Mandatory Driver's meeting:** The chairperson in charge of the race will announce to all drivers; how many races & runs per race will occur; Run Groups-the order of who will race; who will go work the course first; how penalties are imposed; and other pertinent information.

**The Grid:** This is the area where cars that are ready to race will park. Normally a grid person will wave you out when its your turn to drive up to the starting area for your lap / run.

Once you've completed a run, be sure to check your score to see how well you did. You can also compare your score to others. If you do not complete the course correctly (i.e. drive on the wrong side of a cone) you will see a "DNF" (Did Not Finish). You will also realize just how much you know about your car and yourself ...

### Corvette 101 – Part 6 Corvettes for Newbies 1968 Corvette Background Information (not all-inclusive)

by VetteFacts.com

"Corvette '68... all different, all over". That's the quote from the sales brochure for the first version of the third generation 1968 Corvette, AKA the Corvette C3. The body was completely redesigned with the coupe losing its fastback window but gaining a removable back window and, new to Corvettes, removable Ttops for that almost convertible feel. The chassis did not change much from the 1967 model.



The new hidden wipers and hidden headlights are vacuum operated instead of electrical. Door openers now use a push button to open and a push in handle to pull the door, this was only used on the 1968 model. The new auxiliary top for the convertible has a glass rear window. The new standard automatic was the 3-speed Turbo Hydra-Matic instead of the 2-speed Power Glide used previously. A new fiber-optic monitoring system was added to the dash and "Astro-Ventilation" was added to improve the airflow in the cabin, especially since there were no vent windows on the doors. The '68 Corvette did not have the "Sting Ray" badging on it anywhere, but it would return in '69 as "Stingray" (one word). Also, 1968 was also the year that Zora Arkus-Duntov was named Chief Engineer of the Corvette. The base price for a 1968 Corvette Coupe was \$4,663.00 while the 1968 Corvette Convertible sold for \$4,320.00.


