First 2025 Corvette ZR1 Completed at Bowling Green!

Sources are telling our friends at the <u>MidEngineCorvetteForum.com</u> to speculate no longer as the first EX-VIN Corvette ZR1 was completed on February 13th. This would be the first ZR1 prototype to be completed on the actual assembly line and not somewhere behind closed doors like the current group of cars currently being tested. An EX-VIN means the model is an experimental prototype that will eventually be destroyed following its testing. John at the Mid Engine Corvette Forum says his little birdie is a 100% reliable source, so that's good enough for us.



This news comes just days after the <u>latest public sighting</u> of the camouflaged prototype Corvette ZR1s as they engineers were testing in the mountains outside of San Diego, California.

The Corvette ZR1 is rumored to utilize the Z06's 5.5L motor equipped with twin turbos that will provide somewhere around 800-850 horsepower. The new engine will be designated the LT7, and unlike the naturally aspirated LT6 in the Z06, the new motor will have variable valve timing (VVT) and Active Fuel Management (AFM) technology. These details were <u>contained in a leak</u> of the motor within Chevy's own parts catalog last October.

So far as we know, the ZR1 is still on track for a 2025 model-year reveal, and we previously detailed a 2023 meeting at the Bowling Green facility between plant officials and those from Detroit, with the outcome being the new Corvette ZR1 slated for a 2025 release. However, with the first EX-VIN prototypes now coming off the line, it still feels like we are about a year away at least from having the car ready to produce for customers.







Corvette 101 – Part 5 ... Corvettes for Newbies 1963 Corvette Sting Ray Information (not all-inclusive)



Corvette's designers and engineers knew that after 10 years in its basic form, albeit improved, it was time to move on. After years of tweaking the original design, the second generation, or "C2", was dubbed "Sting Ray" in 1963 with a completely new body style featuring the distinctive "split rear window".

The C2 inspiration was drawn from several sources: the contemporary Jaguar E-Type, one of which designer Bill Mitchell owned and enjoyed driving frequently; the radical Sting Ray Racer Mitchell designed in 1959, and a Mako Shark that Mitchell caught while deep-sea fishing.

Zora Arkus Duntov disliked the split rear window (which also raised safety concerns due to reduced visibility) and it was discontinued in 1964, as were the fake hood vents. The 1963 Corvette Sting Ray not only had a new design, but also newfound handling prowess. It was also a somewhat lighter Corvette than previous models, so acceleration improved despite unchanged horsepower.

For the 1963 model year, a total of 21,513 units would be built, which was up 50 percent from the recordsetting 1962 version. Production was divided almost evenly between the convertible and the split window coupe – 10,919 and 10,594, respectively. More than half the convertibles were ordered with the optional liftoff hardtop. Nevertheless, the coupe wouldn't sell as well again throughout the C2 Sting Ray years. The closed Corvette did not outsell the open one until 1969, by which time the coupe came with a T-top featuring removable roof panels.

Equipment installations for 1963 began reflecting the market's demand for more civility in sporting cars. The power brake option went into 15 percent of production. Power steering into 12 percent. On the other hand, only 278 buyers specified the \$421.80 air conditioning. Leather upholstery – a mere \$80.70 – was ordered on only 1,114 cars. The cast aluminum knock-off wheels, manufactured for Chevrolet by Kelsey-Hayes, cost \$322.80 a set, but few buyers checked off that option. However, almost 18,000 Sting Rays left the St. Louis Corvette Plant with the four-speed manual gearbox – better than four out of every five. All 1963 cars had 327 cu. in. engines, which made 250 hp standard, with optional variants that made 300 hp, 340 hp and 360 hp. The most powerful engine was the Rochester fuel injected engine. Options also included an available AM-FM radio.

Also available for the first time ever on a Corvette was a special performance equipment package called the **RPO Z06**, for a "whopping" \$1,818.45. These Corvettes came to be known as the "Big Tanks" because the package initially had a 36.5-US-gallon gas tank versus the standard 20-gallon for races such as Sebring and Daytona. In 1963 only 199 Z06 Corvettes were produced, usually reserved for racing. Of the 199, a total of six were specifically created for Le Mans racing by Chevrolet. One of the six 1963 Z06 Sting Rays was built late in 1962 to race specifically at Riverside on 13 October 1962. They were destined to compete in a different sort of race for sports cars, a NASCAR sanctioned event on the famous Daytona Oval, the Daytona 250 – American Challenge Cup. This meant the cars needed to be prepared to a different set of rules, the same as those for the big Grand National stock cars. The chassis was modified extensively and an experimental 427 cu. in. engine installed. The car was lightened in every way possible and weighed just over 2,800 lbs. Further prep was done by Mickey Thompson. Among other changes, Thompson replaced the fiberglass Z06 "Big Tank" with an even larger 50 US gallon metal fuel tank. Driven by Junior Johnson, but plagued by rain in the race, substitute driver Billy Krause finished in third place behind Paul Goldsmith's Pontiac Tempest and none-other than A. J. Foyt in another Corvette.

2023 Stingray Transmission Update

When GM first introduced the 2020 Corvette, the owner's manual called for adding an additional two quarts of fluid to the dual-clutch transmission for those who were taking their cars to the track. In 2024, the Corvette Stingray received a redesigned transmission pan so adding the two quarts was no longer required.

However, that change with the transmission case was a running production update which happened during the 2023 model year without the owner's manual being updated. So unsuspecting owners reading the manual may think they need to add the additional fluid before heading to the track when it's actually not needed.

Thanks to Mike Furman@Criswell, we discovered when the Stingray's DCTs were changed during the 2023 model year. It was known that it was between mid June and early-ish July but we never had precise info until Mike found this. He called one of his insider friends and learned that on June 23, 2023 was the introduction of the revised transfer case, with its among other changes, moving the internal oil pick up point to a more efficient location. This means new Stingrays going to the track with the new DCT pan no longer need to add the two extra quarts of fluid.

Which exact VIN was the revised DCT fluid pan introduced? It was introduced on Stingray # P5137263. So for the regular 2023 Stingrays, the break point comes at sequence #37263. But what about the **70th** Anniversary Editions? Corvette's Product Marketing Manager Harlan Charles says that the DCT pan break point for the 70th Anniversary Editions was sequence #3905.

So how many of these new DCT fluid pans were delivered in 2023? Chevrolet built a combined 47,372 Stingrays for the 2023 model year with 42,793 regular Stingrays and 4,579 70th Anniversary Stingray models. Based on these VIN break points, there are 5,530 Stingrays and 674 70th Anniversary Stingrays with the updated DCT. **Click This Link For Details**






